A Short Term Team traveled to the Philippines from April 6-22 to provide medical treatment in the areas where we have churches. The team traveled to the islands of Palawan, Cebu, Bohol, and Mindanao. Seven clinics were held and 825 patients were seen and given free medicine. Dr. Don Ribeiro, pastor of the Ormondsville Free Will Baptist Church, took time from his medical practice and his church to provide these free clinics. Each patient was also given a personal witness and a prayer before they left the clinic. It was a thrill to see our pastors and workers praying with all these people.
